FEES, PAYMENT AND SUMS FIXED AND SETTLED UNDER
SECTION 34 OF THE BURIAL ACT, 1852 AND APPROVED
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

1. INTERMENTS FEES

The fee, payments and sums set out below, include the digging of the grave **only** where the interment is made between the hours of 9.00am and 3.30pm on Tuesday to Thursday and 9.00am to 1.30 pm on Fridays.

For permission to erect a headstone or memorial tablet or add an inscription on a grave or Cremated Remains for which the Exclusive Rights of Burial have previously been purchased.	£100.00	£200.00
Permission to install a Vase	£75.00	£100.00
Internments of all persons under eighteen years of age excluding Exclusive Rights of Burial Grant.	Free	£150.00
Transfer of Exclusive Rights of Burial	£50.00	£50.00

Note:

Single burial fees will be charged for the interment of any individual who was living in a care home at the time of death if it can be established that they were previously a resident of Thornley.

Interment fees will be doubled for all internments taking place on a Monday or Saturday between the hours of 9.00am and 3.30pm.

Interment fees will be trebled for all internments taking place on a Statutory Bank Holiday (or the day immediately following) or any other day when Local Authorities are not normally manned.

The Council will not permit the digging of "Double Depth" Graves

Interments outside normal working hours will only be accepted by prior agreement or on the certification of a coroner or registered medical practitioner that immediate interment is necessary.

HEADSTONES MONUMENTS, TABLETS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

1.1. HEADSTONES ETC

The Parish Council will not permit the erection of any monument or headstone in excess of 3 feet in height

Flat tablets (or School desk types) must not be in excess of 18 inches square must be placed on a foundation stone not exceeding 23 inches by 23 inches by 2 inches.

In addition to the above the following additional charges will be made by the Council where this applies:-

- For the excavation for foundation for memorials £125.00

1.2. MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

- Search of Record £10.00
